Diamond Road Parking

This petition is being carried out by Diamond Road and side streets residents to air concerns regarding parking problems affecting our area.

Main Problems:

- Non local residents parking their vehicles in the morning and heading to their work places, returning after normal hours.
- Residents resorting to putting bins and cones outside their properties in order to "reserve" parking.
- Local residents being penalised with penalty charge notices for "illegal parking".
- Parking site for traders dealing in car sales.

Proposal:

- We propose a resident parking ONLY.
- Limited parking for Local Trade.
- Parking to be allowed for 1 hour ONLY. Parking outside this time will mean a penalty notice.
