Decisions to be made by the Cabinet in private as a matter of urgency Date of Notice: 5th September 2014

Local authorities are required to publish a Notice of key decisions and/or of their intention to hold a meeting of the Executive ('the Cabinet') in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. Reason for urgency	The Published Notification of Decisions for September to November 2014 included notice of a decision(s) expected to be taken in a report titled 'Arbour Park'. Since publication of this Statutory Notice on 15 th August 2014, this report has been retitled, as above, and extended to take a decision on a further Free School site. It is considered that a new Notice is therefore required. The decisions cannot reasonably be deferred as delaying the agreement of the heads of terms would risk undue delay in delivery of the School Places Strategy.
Reason for decision to be made under Part II	The item involves the likely disclosure of exempt information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the Authority holding the information) as defined in Paragraph 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 (amended).
