Babies and toddlers will love sharing these books with you – then perhaps you can try to spot the cars, trucks and other things that go when you are out and about together!








Wilbur's book of things that go by Valerie Thomas

Help Spot drive a car, a train, a boat, a tractor, a bus and even a plane - what a busy puppy! For energetic one year olds and above.




Wheels on the Bus by Wes Magee


We have lift off by Sean Taylor


Dinosaur Zoom by Penny Dale


Dig dig digging by Margaret Mayo
