Slough Borough Council Covid-19 recovery survey






Q1: Overall, how would you rate the council's performance in managing the local response to Covid-19?


Q2: Were you aware of the One Slough volunteer hub offering support with food, prescriptions and welfare?


Q3: Were you aware of the extra financial assistance being offered by the council?


Q4: Were you aware of the council services affected by Covid-19 and how they were affected?






Q8: Has your household income been affected by Covid-19

Q9: Have you accessed any council support for financial hardship – for example local welfare payment, benefits, council tax support




Q10: How often are you exercising now compared to before Covid-19?




Q11: How connected do you feel to your local community now compared to before Covid-19?




Q12: How often did you use local shops (within Slough) either by visiting or shopping online BEFORE Covid-19


Q13: How often have you used local shops (within Slough) either by visiting or shopping online SINCE Covid-19?


Q17: If the council's budget is severely affected by Covid-19 which services would you prioritise for funding? (Please tick your top 3)



Q18: What are the positive impacts of Covid-19 in Slough which you would like to keep in the future?





Q24: Which of the following best describes your gender?


