

Directions and Access to Herschel Park Slough

Herschel Park is easily accessible by public transport, on foot or by cycle or car. The accompanying Location Map and Parking and Access Plan show the park's location and suitable points of access

By car:

There is free parking for cars in the Nature Reserve car park (post code SL3 7NR) together with free disabled and mini-bus parking (by arrangement only) near the Kiosk entrance which is accessible from Upton Close (SL1 2DG)

By foot or by bike:

There are 6 pedestrian entrances to the park, 2 of which are also suitable for cyclists. The Heritage Park is accessed through the privately owned roads of Upton Park and Upton Close or through the Nature Reserve. A shared-use cycleway and footpath provides access through the Heritage Park and Nature Reserve and joins Datchet Road to Windsor Road and links to walking and cycling network. There are cycle racks in the Nature Reserve car park and by the Kiosk in the Heritage Park

Buses:

Bus No. 77 stops at the Windsor Road entrance and Bus No. 60 stops near the Datchet Road car park

Trains:

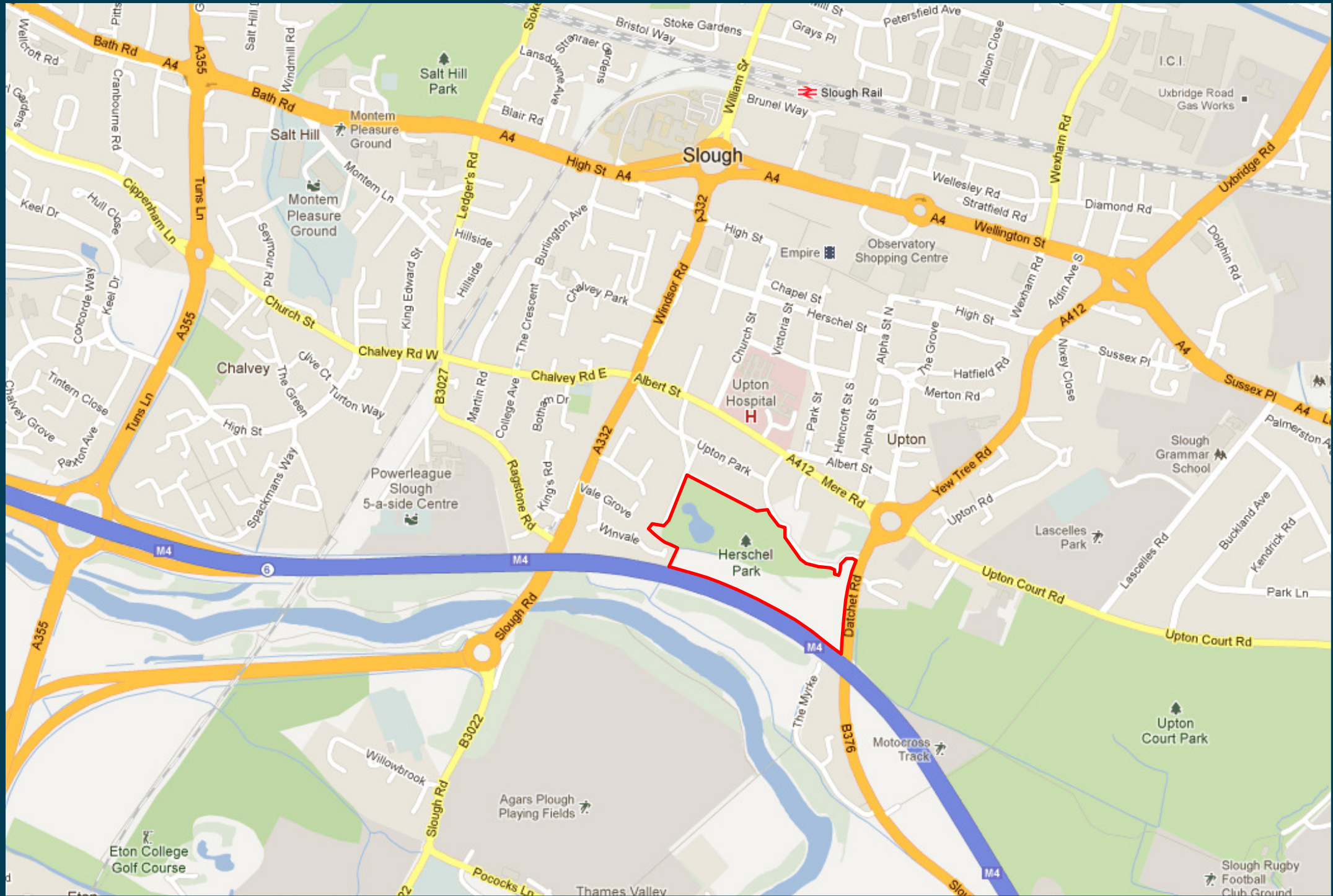
The nearest railway station is Slough Central which is a 15 minute walk from the park
