AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT (NO 3) ORDER 2011

Slough Borough Council in the exercise of powers conferred by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995 makes the following Order:-

The area shown on the attached map edged blue is to be designated as an air quality management area ("the Designated Area"). The Designated Area incorporates the A355 Tuns Lane from junction 6 of the M4 motorway in a northerly direction to just past its junction with the A4 Bath Road and A355 Farnham Road, known as the "Three Tuns".

The map may be viewed at the Council Offices, St Martins Place, 51 Bath Road, Slough, Berkshire, SL1 3UF during normal working hours.

The area is designated in relation to a likely breach of the nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations (England and Wales) 2000 (SI 928), The Air Quality (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2002 (SI 3043).

This Order shall remain in force until revoked.

This Order may be referred to as the Slough Borough Council Air Quality Management (No 3) Order 2011 and shall come into effect on
