AQMA Order 3 Extended

Slough Borough Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order.

This Order may be cited/referred to as the Slough Borough Council Air Quality Management Area No3 extended and shall come into effect on 10 May 2018.

The area shown on the attached maps includes the existing AQMA 3 order and the new extended AQMA 3 is shown in blue outline (shaded in pink) and is to be designated as an air quality management area (the designated area).

The designated area incorporates a stretch of road between Tuns Lane Junction known as the "Three Tuns" and 30 Bath Road and also includes Quadrivium Point. The map may be viewed at the Council Offices.


This Area is designated in relation to a likely breach of the nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations 2010.

This Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order.

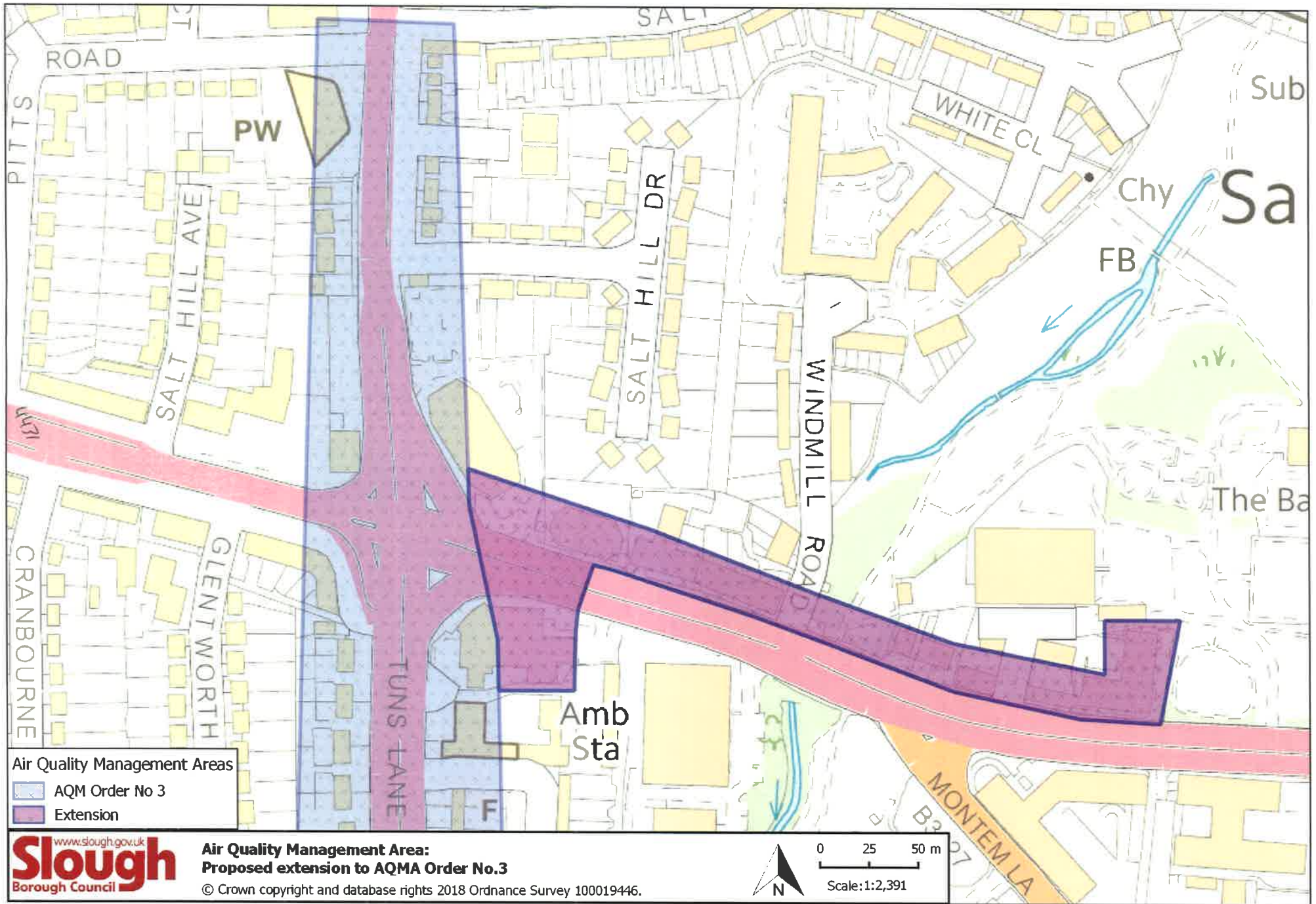
