THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH (HIGH STREET (B470)) LEFT-TURN ONLY TRAFFIC ORDER 2020 (ORDER 54 of 2020) (“Order”)

1. SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers.
2. This Order shall come into operation on the date stated in the notice of its making.
3. While the Order is in operation, every person causing any vehicle proceeding in a southerly direction in the left or nearside lane of High Street (B470) shall, on reaching the junction with London Road (A4), cause that vehicle to turn left into London Road (A4) only.
4. Nothing in paragraph 3 shall apply to a vehicle which is:-
 - directed as authorised by a police constable in uniform; or
 - being used for emergency services purposes.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed left-turn only signage is part of a package of improvements at the junction of High Street (B470) and London Road (A4) to improve safety and improve the clarity of the junction's operation to drivers. The proposed improvements were identified through a safety review of the junction. The left-turn only signage is intended to clarify to drivers the purpose and operation of the nearside lane and its associated traffic signal.
