Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 (TPCA 1847)

Borough of Slough (temporary closure of roads for the Vaisakhi event 2024 (Order 18 of 2024)

- 1. Slough Borough Council gives notice that it has made an Order under section 21 of the TPCA 1847 and any other enabling powers over areas of the highway being:
 - i) The Frithe (between its junctions with Berryfield and Knolton Way)
 - ii) Knolton Way (Between its junctions with Almons Way and Wexham Road
 - iii) Wexham Road (between its junctions with Norway Drive and Grasmere Avenue)
 - iv) Shaggy Calf Lane (for its entire length)
 - v) Elliman Avenue (between its junctions with Stoke Road and Stoke Poges Lane)
 - vi) Stoke Poges Lane (between its junctions with Elliman Avenue and Lansdowne Avenue)
 - vii) Baylis Road (between its junctions with Stoke Poges Lane and Woodland Avenue)
 - viii) Woodland Avenue (between its junctions with Baylis Road and Lake Avenue)
- 2. The Order is made to protect public safety and to regulate traffic and prevent obstruction of the streets when they are likely to be crowded during the Vaisakhi Event.
- 3. The Order shall come into operation on Sunday 28th April 2024 from 9:30 to 16:00.
- 4. While the Order is in operation, all traffic including bicycle (but not including pedestrian) movement along the highways specified in paragraph 1 will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access).
- 5. A 'rolling road closure' will be in place, with roads being closed prior to the arrival of the procession, and reopened once the procession has moved on.
- 6. Appropriate signage will be lawfully displayed on the day along the route.
- 7. Alternative routes will be available whilst the Order is in operation.
- 8. All restrictions will be signed (and staffed) and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.
- 9. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer.
 - Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or the purposes of
 a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water
 to premises in the area, which requires vehicles to be brought onto a section of highway to which
 the Order applies.
 - Any vehicle used in connection with the Vaisakhi Event 2024.
- 10. Access to properties adjoining the highway specified in paragraph 1 will not be affected.
