Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 (TPCA 1847) borough of Slough (temporary closure of roads for the Vaisakhi event 2024 (order 18 of 2024)

- Slough Borough Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 21 of the TPCA 1847 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being:
- The Frithe (between its junctions with Berryfield and Knolton Way)
- Knolton Way (Between its junctions with Almons Way and Wexham road
- Wexham Road (between its junctions with Norway Drive and Grasmere Avenue)
- Shaggy Calf Lane (for its entire length)
- Elliman Avenue (between its junctions with Stoke Road and Stoke Poges Lane)
- Stoke Poges Lane (between its junctions with Elliman Avenue and Lansdowne Avenue)
- Baylis Road (between its junctions with Stoke Poges Lane and Woodland Avenue)
- Woodland Avenue (between its junctions with Baylis Road and Lake Avenue)
- 2. The Order is made to avoid obstruction of the highways specified in paragraph 1 during the Vaisakhi Event.
- 3. The Order shall come into operation at 9:30 on 28th April 2024 and will remain in force until 16:00 on 28th April 2024.
- 4. While the Order is in operation traffic including bicycle and pedestrian movement along the roads will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access)
- 5. All restrictions will be signed and staffed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.
- 6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer.
 - Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which requires vehicles to be brought onto a section of highway to which the Order applies.
