

## **SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL**

### **THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH (LONDON ROAD) BUS LANE ORDER 2024 (Order 52 of 2024)**

**Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 7 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 as amended.**

1. SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers. The effects of the Order are set out below.
2. New bus lanes would be created on both sides of London Road, located between its junction with Hillrise and No. 550 London Road, operating between 7am and 10am and between 3pm and 7pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive. Vehicles such as buses, solo motorcycles, pedal cycles, taxis, private hire vehicles, electric scooters approved by the Council and vehicles with no tail pipe emissions would be exempted from the bus lane prohibitions
3. Copies of the proposed Order, this notice and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected free of charge at the Council's offices during normal working hours (excluding bank and public holidays). 4. **Anyone wishing to object to the proposed Order** may do by writing to the address below or emailing [parking.consultations@slough.gov.uk](mailto:parking.consultations@slough.gov.uk). The objection must be made in writing, stating the grounds on which it is made, and must be sent so as to arrive no later than three weeks from the date of this Notice.
