Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 (TPCA 1847)

Borough of Slough (temporary closure of roads for the Remembrance Day (Langley) procession 2024 (order 57 of 2024)

1. Slough Borough Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 21 of the TPCA 1847 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being:
 - Parlaunt Road, from the "Worker Church" through to its junction with High Street Langley, and
 - High Street Langley from its junction with Parlaunt Road to the Memorial Ground opposite Harrow Market.
2. The Order is made to avoid obstruction of the highway, regulate traffic and maintain public safety during the period in which the procession is being held.
3. The Order shall come into operation at 10:00 on Sunday 10th November 2024 and shall remain in force until 13:00 on Sunday 10th November 2024.
4. While the Order is in operation, traffic movement along the roads will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access) between 10:00-13:00 on 10th November 2024.
5. All restrictions will be signed and staffed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.
6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer.
 - Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or for the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which requires vehicles to be brought onto a section of highway to which the Order applies.
