THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 63) WIDTH RESTRICTION (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2024 (Order 63 of 2024) Sections 9 and 10 and Part III & IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and regulation 22 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996.

- 1. SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL makes this Order in exercise of its powers under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers.
- 2. The Order shall come into operation on the date upon which its Notice of Making is published and shall remain in force for a period not exceeding 18 months.
- 3. In pursuance of Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the delegated authority of Slough Borough Council, or some person authorised in that behalf, may if it appears essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend this Order or any provision thereof.
- 4. While the Order is in operation no person shall cause any vehicle the overall width of which together with the load (if any) carried thereon exceeds 2.7 metres to enter that point of Poyle Road which lies at a point 46 metres north east of a point opposite the north eastern kerb line of Mathisen Way.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order designates a width restriction in Poyle Road.

The scheme is designed to reduce the movement of heavy goods vehicles (HGVs), thereby reducing congestion, improving air quality, and creating a safer environment for all road users. It is also designed to enhance road safety for vulnerable road users, including pedestrians and cyclists, on Poyle Road and Bath Road in Slough.
