THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017 (AMENDMENT No. 43) ORDER 2024 (Order 67 of 2024)

Sections 1, 45, 46 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

1. SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL makes this Order in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 45, 46 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers.
2. The Order shall come into operation on the date upon which its Notice of Making is first published.
3. While the Order is in operation, the Slough Borough Council Waiting Restrictions and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2017 shall be amended as set out below and in the attached schedules:

 - (d) The items set out in Schedule D to this Order are added to Schedule 8.01 to the 2017 Order;
 - (e) The items set out in Schedule E to this Order are added to Schedule 8.02 to the 2017 Order;
 - (f) The items set out in Schedule F to this Order are added to Schedule 9.01 to the 2017 Order; and
 - (g) The items set out in Schedule G to this Order are added to Schedule 9.03 to the 2017 Order.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order creates the CP2 residents parking scheme to incorporate the following roads:

Albany Park, part of Bridge Street, Cottesbrooke Close, part of High Street, Colnbrooke, Hunstanton Close, Mill Street, part of Park Street, Rudsworth Close, St. Thomas Walk and Vicarage Way together with the introduction of waiting restrictions operating at all times into certain sections of these roads.

It also introduces pay by phone short term parking places in sections of High Street, Colnbrook and Park Street and introduces a disabled parking place into a certain section of Village Way.

The purpose of this Order is to introduce a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) in line with the CPZ Borough Wide policy. This focuses on introducing CPZs as a standard approach for the provision of parking restrictions which would bring consistency in the management of road space and enable priority for parking to be given to residents and businesses.

The introduction of CPZs will enable the Council to:

- Prioritise parking for residents within the operational times using residents permits. Visitors vouchers will also be available
- Take account of the impact on the local amenities e.g. shops and schools
- Reduce congestion, obstructive and inconsiderate parking especially at junctions, bends and on footways
- Control the number of cars parking on the highway within CPZs

- Manage displacement parking
- Promote sustainability and improve air quality by encouraging commuters to use alternatives to the private car.
